Code of conduct for junior members

As a junior member of Barton AC, you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- Be a good sport (eg shake hands after competing)
- Always show respect to the coach and abide by their decisions (eg listen to what the coach has to say).
- Play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- Play fair at all times. It is the taking part that counts, not winning at all costs.
- Always respect others, regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Do not misbehave.
- Treat all equipment with respect.
- Inform the coach of any injuries or illness you have before the start of the session.
- Do not eat or chew gum during a session.
- Speak out about anything you are not happy with.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Bullying of any sort will not be tolerated.

Persistent bad behaviour or inappropriate behaviour which breaks this code of conduct will be discussed with parents / carers / coaches and committee members and may result in future involvement in the club being refused.
