Code of conduct for parents and carers

The essence of good ethical conduct and practice is summarised below.

We request all parents and carers to:

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Ensure the club has the current emergency contact details for you and another responsible adult.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Inform the club / coach / activity leader of any factors which may impact on a child's participation and enjoyment.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding good performances of all.
- Recognise the valuable contribution made by coaches and officials, who are usually volunteers.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept officials' judgements.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Ensure you do not use language which could be interpreted as offensive to others within the club / competition environment.
- Encourage and guide performers to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
