Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with a member of the Barton AC Committee (available in club and at www.bartonac.co.uk)

As a member of Barton AC, you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- All members must take responsibility in ensuring they are up to date with the rules, understand and adhere to them.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless
 of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Members should recognise the valuable contribution made by coaches and officials, who are usually volunteers.
- All members must respect officials and publicly accept their decisions
- All members should be a positive role model and treat other members, competitors and officials with the same level of respect you would expect to be shown to you.
- Members should not use language which could be interpreted as offensive to others within the club / competition environment.
- Members are not allowed to smoke, consume alcohol or drugs on club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit for training and competitions.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Bullying of any sort will not be tolerated.
